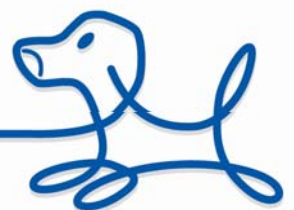
Information about the breed: Beagles are one of the most popular breeds because of their looks, personalities and skills. They make a great family pet (but young children need to be supervised as they have a tendency to pull on their ears which are very sensitive and thin).

Beagles are wonderful with other dogs, especially their own kind. Being a pack animal they love the company of each other and don't suit being an only dog.

Beagles adore their humans and do anything they can to be involved in all aspects of your life. They are inquisitive by nature and will always want to help if you are gardening, hanging out the washing or doing housework!

Beagles are driven by their nose and their tummies and will eat anything within scent and sight. They are a high energy breed so require daily mental and Physical exercise to keep them stimulated and out of trouble! Being Scent Hounds it is essential that they are always exercised on lead, this is not the breed to take to the park and let off to exercise themselves; they will pick up a scent and follow their nose rather than you! They require secure fencing and an active loving family.

Ideal owners for this breed: The ideal owner for a beagle should have a medium to large sized backyard and secure fencing. They should love going for walks and being active as beagles benefit immensely from daily exercise although they will also understand that a beagle cannot be walked off-lead. To get the best out of their beagle, the ideal beagle owner will let their beagle be a part of their family i.e. taking their beagle on day trips in the car; to the beach; letting them watch TV with the family and let their beagle sleep inside. The ideal beagle owner will understand that their beagle is at his best with love and affection and being involved with their pack.



How this rescue program works: We are a not-for-profit organisation established for the sole purpose of rescuing, rehabilitating and rehoming any impounded, stray or unwanted beagle or beagle cross in need in Victoria.

As part of our code of ethics (we belong to the MDBA), each beagle is desexed, microchipped, vaccinated, heartworm tested (and treated if necessary), flead and wormed and temperament tested before being rehomed. Each beagle is provided with a safe and nurturing environment whilst they are in our care, they are temperament tested and, where required, rehabilitation and medical care is provided.

If you are looking to adopt one of our rescue beagles, we ask that an adoption form (available from our website) be completed and returned to us. If all is in order, we then like to meet our prospective new family and make sure the yard and fencing is adequate enough for our beagle friend. If there is a particular beagle (from our Available Beagles page on our website) that you were interested in, we would do our best to bring him/her with us for the “meet and greet”.



If all went well at the “meet and greet”, and if convenient to all parties, we would then arrange for our beagle to stay for a trial period. If, after the trial period - or indeed at any time during the trial period - you decide you would like to make the beagle yours, we will have the necessary paperwork drawn up to hand ownership from Beagle Rescue Victoria over to you. However, if at any time during the trial period, it becomes apparent that that beagle isn't the one for you, a telephone call is all that is required for a member of Beagle Rescue Victoria to come and retrieve the beagle within 24 hours.

We know that settling a rescue beagle into a new environment isn't always easy so we encourage people to contact us at any time and for whatever reason. We are always available for backup and support, even after the trial period has ended and the beagle is officially yours.
